CHANGE OF NAME

Members of the Parish Council have been giving some thought to the possibility of changing the name of the Council to 'Myddle and Harmer Hill Parish Council' or 'Harmer Hill and Myddle' Parish Council

The name Broughton is a historical name dating back to 1891 but the change would reflect the importance of Harmer Hill and allow residents there to relate more closely with the Council. Outside the Parish it would also help people to more clearly identify the actual parameters of the Council.

To change the name is not difficult – all that is needed is a resolution passed at a Parish Council meeting, details of which are forwarded to the Elections team at Shirehall who do the rest. Although a decision is made relatively quickly any change would not come into force until the next elections in 2017.

Members of the Council will be discussing the possible change at the next Council meeting and there will be a resolution tabled to effect the change. If you wish to comment on this possible change you should attend the Council Meeting in Myddle Village Hall on Wednesday March 5th. starting at 7.30pm.
